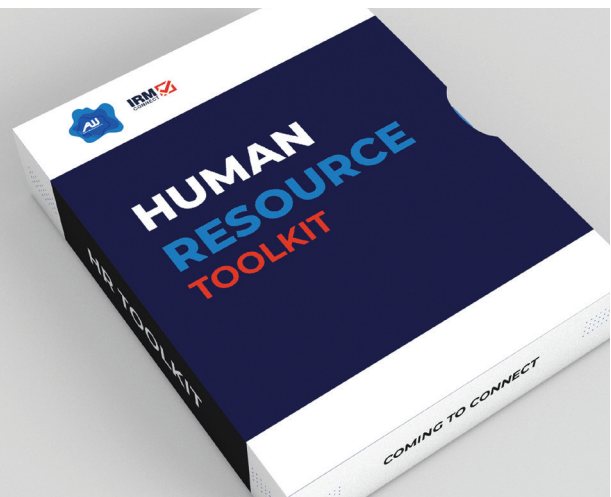

2 former directors have been sentenced and fined after a safety breach involving asbestos.

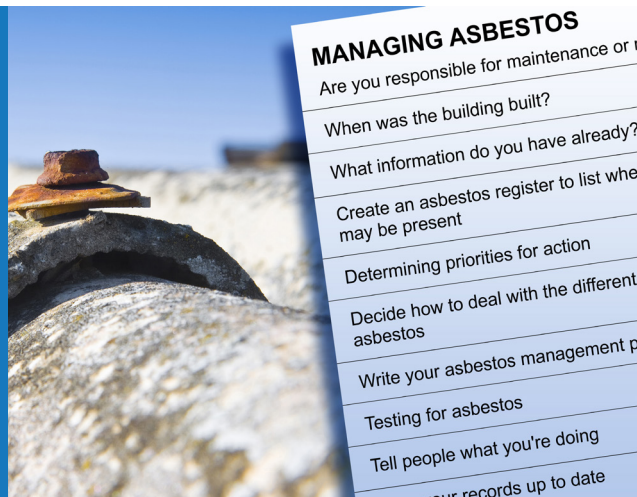
